VENUE:

On 10/5/17 at approximately 0110 hours I Deputy Carter along with Deputy Faouzi were dispatched to [REDACTED] reference to a domestic situation. As we were responding Dispatch advised that suspect Tyler Kolbe had left in his 2007 Chevy Malibu and would be waiting at the intersection of Coonhill and Erica Drive. Upon our arrival I made contact with Tyler.

INTERVIEW SUSPECT:

Deputy Faouzi and myself approached the 2007 Chevy Malibu, silver in color with Michigan registration DSW5937 and asked Tyler to step out of the vehicle. It should be noted that Tyler was sitting in the driver's seat. After Tyler stepped out of the vehicle I noticed a strong odor of intoxicants coming from his person. I also noticed that Tyler's eyes were glassy and bloodshot. I asked Tyler what had taken place at the residence.

Tyler stated that he got into an argument with his mom because his mom did not want him to drink at the residence. Tyler stated that he was not aware of that when he started drinking earlier on the 10/4/17. Tyler stated that his mother told him that he had to leave the residence because it was not where he was living. I asked Tyler where he was living at. Tyler stated he was living at the above address since June. I advised Tyler that he had established residency and he did not have to leave the residence.

I asked Tyler if there was anything physical between his mom and himself. Tyler stated no. Tyler stated that he then called 911 due to the fact that he had been in a domestic with his father before and wanted to protect himself. Tyler stated that as he was on the phone with Dispatch, Dispatch told him to leave the residence and that is why he did so.

It should be noted that I made contact with Dispatcher Berkeypile who spoke to Tyler on the phone and Dispatcher Berkeypile stated that she did not tell Tyler to leave the residence she simply informed him that if he wanted to speak to the police he needed to stay in the area. Tyler stated that he then got into the above vehicle and drove to the intersection of Coonhill and Erica Drive where he parked and waited for the police to arrive.

SOBRIETY EXERCISES:

Prior to having Tyler perform the below sobriety exercises I asked Tyler what level of education he had. Tyler stated that he was in [REDACTED]. I asked Tyler if he knew how to recite the alphabet. Tyler stated yes. I asked Tyler if he knew how to count from 1 to 20 and 20 back to 0. Tyler stated yes. I asked Tyler if he knew what day of the week it was. Tyler stated Thursday. I asked Tyler if he knew what time it was.

Tyler stated midnight; actual time was 0200 hours. I asked Tyler if he knew what road he was on. Tyler stated Coonhill Road. I asked Tyler if he had any physical disabilities. [REDACTED] I asked Tyler if he takes medication for that. Tyler stated yes. I asked Tyler when the last time was he took the medication for the [REDACTED]. Tyler stated earlier on 10/4/17.

I asked Tyler if he was supposed to consume alcohol while he was on the medication. Tyler stated that he had never been advised by his doctor that it was unsafe. I asked Tyler how much alcohol he had consumed. Tyler stated two beers which is equivalent to approximately 8 domestic beers due to the percentage of alcohol in them. I asked Tyler what time he started drinking. Tyler stated approximately 6:00 p.m. I asked Tyler what time he stopped drinking. Tyler stated approximately 10:00 p.m.

Recite the Alphabet:

Fail.

Count from 1 to 20:

Pass.

Count from 20 back to 10:

Pass.

Heel to Toe Walk:

Fail. Tyler was unable to keep his balance during the instructions. Tyler did not step heel to toe and after he completed 9 steps he made a 90 degree turn and continued the exercise.

One Leg Stand:

Fail. Tyler put his foot down and then continued and stopped at the number 10.

PRELIMINARY BREATH TEST (PBT):

I advised Tyler of his PBT rights. Tyler stated he understood his rights and would submit to a PBT. Result .22 percent.

ARREST:

I advised Tyler that he was under arrest for OWI. I placed handcuffs on Tyler behind his back; they were double locked and checked for tightness. I searched Tyler's person for any weapons or contraband; none were located. Tyler was then placed in the back seat of my patrol vehicle.

VEHICLE DISPOSITION:

A Jackson County impounded vehicle inventory form was completed on the above vehicle. Brewster's Towing responded and towed the vehicle to their impound lot. A copy of the inventory form was later placed in the tow book at JSO.

CHEMICAL TEST RIGHTS:

Prior to reading Tyler his chemical test rights I asked Tyler if he could hear me okay through the police screen. Tyler stated yes. The car stereo and police radio were turned down so there would be no interference. I read Tyler his chemical test rights at 0215 hours. After completing them I asked Tyler if he understood them.

Tyler stated that if he was not going to be allowed to listen to the 911 tape of the conversation he had with Dispatch when he called 911 he was not going to answer any questions. I advised Tyler that, that was two separate situations and I was simply asking him if he understood his chemical test rights. Tyler stated no. I asked Tyler what he did not understand of the chemical test rights. Tyler then continued talking about the 911 recording.

AFFIDAVIT:

An affidavit was completed and contact was made with Judge Mazur. After swearing to the affidavit it was faxed to Judge Mazur which the search warrant was authorized. I advised Tyler that I had obtained a search warrant from Judge Mazur to take a blood specimen from him. This was done at HFA Hospital.

LEGAL DRAW:

Lab tech/witness Carol McEldowney extracted two vials of blood from Tyler at 0314 hours. The two vials of blood were labeled and placed into the blood kit. A copy of the FSD-93 form was also placed into the blood kit. The blood kit was sealed at HFA Hospital in front of Carol McEldowney. The blood kit was later placed in the post office box in front of the post office on Michigan Avenue to be forwarded to the MSP Crime Lab for analysis.

LODGED:

Tyler was transported to the Jackson County Jail. Upon our arrival Tyler was lodged on the charge of OWI/High BAC. Copies of the DI-93, search warrant and return to search were left with Tyler's property.

SOS ENTRY:

A copy of the DI-93 form was faxed to Dispatch to be entered into SOS.

ORIGINAL AFFIDAVIT:

The original affidavit along with the return to search was placed on Deputy Cherry's desk to be forwarded to Judge Mazur.

WARRANT REQUEST:

A warrant request was completed on Tyler requesting the charge OWI/High BAC. A probable cause sheet was also completed and attached to the report in Aegis.

EMAIL:

An email was sent to the Prosecutor's Office advising them that this report was ready for review.
