Dear Judge Chupp:

I write on behalf of Monica Rial and Ron Toye ("Moving Defendants") concerning the form of the Order for the November 8, 2019 hearing.

We were not able to reach agreement on the form of the Order, as Plaintiff's counsel is opposed to including language concerning the Moving Defendants right to "reurge" the request to depose Mr. Slatosch at the November 21, 2019 hearing. Specifically, the following language is at issue, with the strikeouts being advocated by Plaintiff.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that Monica Rial and Ronald Toye's Motion to Compel is DENIED, ~~but Moving Defendants have the option to reurge the relief sought at the hearing on November 21, 2019.~~

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that Plaintiff's Amended Motion to Quash and Motion for Protective Order is GRANTED, ~~subject to Moving Defendants' right to reurge the relief sought at the hearing on November 21, 2019.~~

Therefore, we are submitting an Order in the form we believe meets the Court's ruling.
