

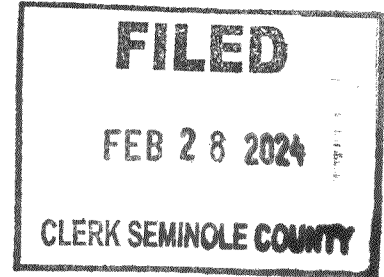

**ORDER GRANTING THE STATE'S MOTION TO DECLARE  
PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION INFORMATION OF COURT PERSONNEL  
AND WITNESSES CONFIDENTIAL**

**THIS CAUSE**, having come before the Court *In Camera* upon the State's Motion to Declare Personal Identification Information of Court Personnel and Witnesses Confidential, and having been advised that [Redacted]

[Redacted] along with [Redacted] stipulate to the relief sought by the State in its Motion and this Court's In Camera review of same,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that said Motion is hereby **GRANTED**.

This Court **FINDS** that the personal identification information of Court personnel and witnesses in the Court file is **CONFIDENTIAL**.

The Clerk of the Court **SHALL** redact the personal identification information of all **COURT PERSONNEL** (to include but not limited to: members of Law Enforcement, Assistant State Attorneys, Office of the State Attorney personnel, Defense Counsel and his/her/their personnel, Clerk of the Court personnel, and Judicial Administration personnel) and **WITNESSES** from the Court file. Personal identification information includes the following: name, postal address, physical address, phone number, email address, Florida Bar Number, Agency Identification or Badge Number, professional title, signature, or any other means by which Court personnel or witnesses could be identified.

The Clerk of the Court **SHALL** make said redactions without a Notice of Confidential Information in a Court Filing being contemporaneously filed.

This Court's confidentiality determinations **SHALL** apply should the Office of the State Attorney or other law enforcement agencies receive a public records request. The Office of the State Attorney and law enforcement agencies **SHALL** redact the personal identification

information of Court personnel and witnesses from records, documents, or items subject to public record under Florida State Statutes Chapter 119.
