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NARRATIVE

OFFICER ACTIONS:

On 12/23/2022 at 1755 hours, I was dispatched to 534 Vandehei Ave. reference an Impaired Person.

INITIAL CONTACT:

Upon my arrival, I contacted the RP, C [REDACTED] S [REDACTED], who was standing outside of his vehicle, which was parked under the awning at the fuel pumps.

C [REDACTED] stated his 31-year-old son, J [REDACTED] S [REDACTED], is intoxicated and causing a disturbance. C [REDACTED] stated J [REDACTED] consumed an entire bottle of hard alcohol in the vehicle. C [REDACTED] also stated J [REDACTED] made several suicidal and homicidal statements.

C [REDACTED] stated he no longer felt safe living with J [REDACTED] for the rest of the night, especially while J [REDACTED] is intoxicated.

OFFICER OBSERVATIONS:

I then contacted J [REDACTED], who was sitting in the rear passenger side seat of C [REDACTED] vehicle. I observed a strong odor of alcohol coming from J [REDACTED] during my contact with him. I also observed J [REDACTED] eyes, which were bloodshot, watery, and extremely lethargic. J [REDACTED] speech was slurred and slow.

J [REDACTED] S [REDACTED] STATEMENT:

However, J [REDACTED] stated he does not have any desire to harm himself or anyone else several times. J [REDACTED] admitted to drinking alcohol but denied having made any suicidal or homicidal statements earlier in the day.

OFFICER ACTIONS:

I explained to C [REDACTED] and J [REDACTED], I believed it was best for [REDACTED], that I transport him to the ARC so that he can detox from the alcohol he consumed. C [REDACTED] agreed to this plan, and we were inevitably able to have J [REDACTED] agree to go to the ARC as well.

Dispatch advised me that the ARC was having an issue with the heating in their building, and would not be accepting new intakes at this time.

At this point in the contact, C [REDACTED] had departed from the scene. I advised J [REDACTED] that the ARC would no longer be an option for him during this incident.

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NARRATIVE (continuation)

I explained to J [REDACTED] that he could admit himself in to the hospital in order to have his mental health and alcohol consumption evaluated. I also explained to J [REDACTED] that, if he did not want to admit in to the hospital he could stay the night at the Comea Shelter.

J [REDACTED] was adamantly not willing to accept either of these options despite my efforts to convince him it was better than being outside in the below zero degree weather.

I then told J [REDACTED] he could admit himself in to the hospital, or I would place him under arrest for Public Intoxication. J [REDACTED] continued to refuse to go to the hospital.

I placed J [REDACTED] under arrest for Public Intoxication. I then placed J [REDACTED] in to handcuffs using standard cuffing procedures. I transported J [REDACTED] to Laramie County Detention Facility and booked him in under the charge of Public Intoxication.

FOLLOW UP:

I later contacted C [REDACTED] by telephone and advised him that his son, J [REDACTED] was not located at the ARC, and that J [REDACTED] was booked in at Laramie County Detention Facility.
