**AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE
TO SUPPORT CONTINUED
DETENTION OF DEFENDANT**

I, NOAH BERG, swear that I am a Deputy District Attorney for Multnomah County and that I have reviewed the police reports which have been filed in this case by police officers; that the crimes charged against defendant(s) occurred in Multnomah County and that the probable cause for detention following the arrest of defendant(s) is as follows:

On March 27, 2024 Portland Police Bureau Officer Royce Barber reports he spoke via phone with Shawna Lydecker who reported being maced by Isabel ARAUJO at approximately 1310 hours on March 24, 2024. Lydecker explained that she went to Couch Park to counter protest and was pepper sprayed by ARAUJO. Lydecker told Ofc Barber that she recognized ARAUJO's voice and was told by several people who ARAUJO was. Ofc Barber reports Lydecker sent him a link to a Youtube video of the incident that she had posted showing the subject.

PPB Ofc Jason Wands reports that on April 10, 2024 he spoke with Lydecker via phone who stated that she had seen ARAUJO earlier that same day without a mask. Additionally, Lydecker reported that she recognized ARAUJO from other videos online and had contacted an individual who posted one of those videos who told her that the subject was Isabel ARAUJO aka "Aspen." Lydecker told Ofc Wands that the pepper spray had landed on her neck, back, and side of her face; Lydecker reported that "it burned like hell" and continued to burn for 36 hours despite several showers.

On July 13, 2024 PPB Ofc Cristina Serrano reports she was directed to a subject by Ofc Dustin Barth who appeared to match a dragnet flier regarding unlawful use of mace back in March. Ofc Serrano reports she took the individual into custody without incident and the individual identified herself as Isabel ARAUJO, which was confirmed via DMV photograph.

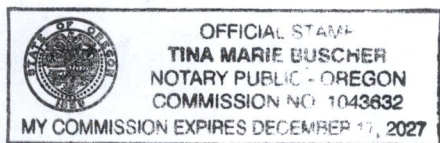
I believe there is probable cause to believe the defendant, **ISABEL ROSA ARAUJO**, has committed the crime(s) of: COUNT 1 - ASSAULT IN THE FOURTH DEGREE, COUNT 2 - HARASSMENT, AND COUNT 3 - UNLAWFUL USE OF STUN GUN, TEAR GAS OR MACE IN THE SECOND DEGREE.
