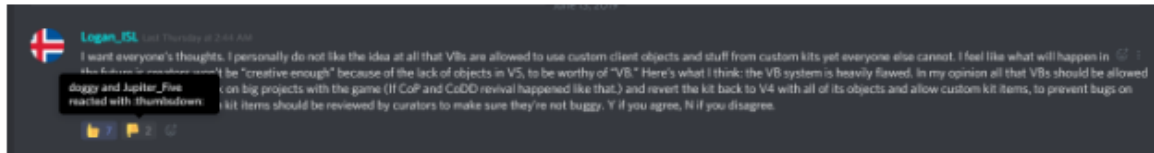

I will be going through each part of the script, debunking some parts and explaining my reasoning on why Awes should not be banned.

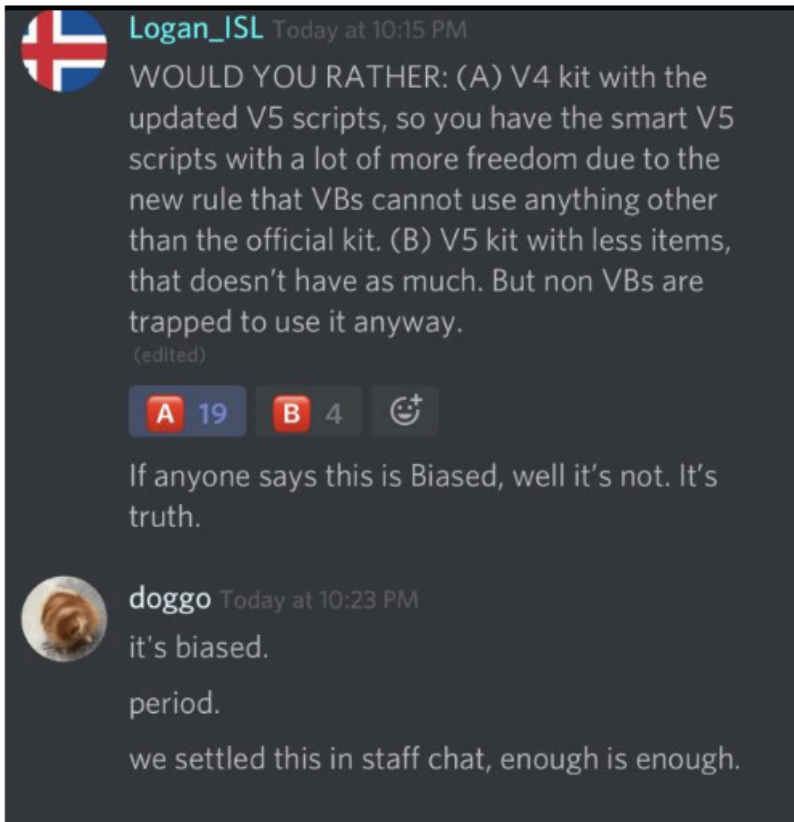
This poll, passed. The staff agreed that voted on this with a vote of 7 to 2. The 2 people who disagreed?

After this, all of the drama was resolved.

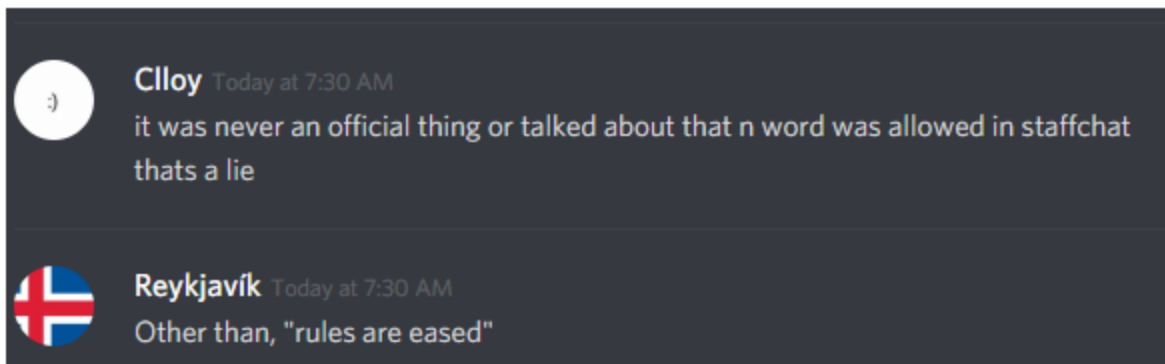
