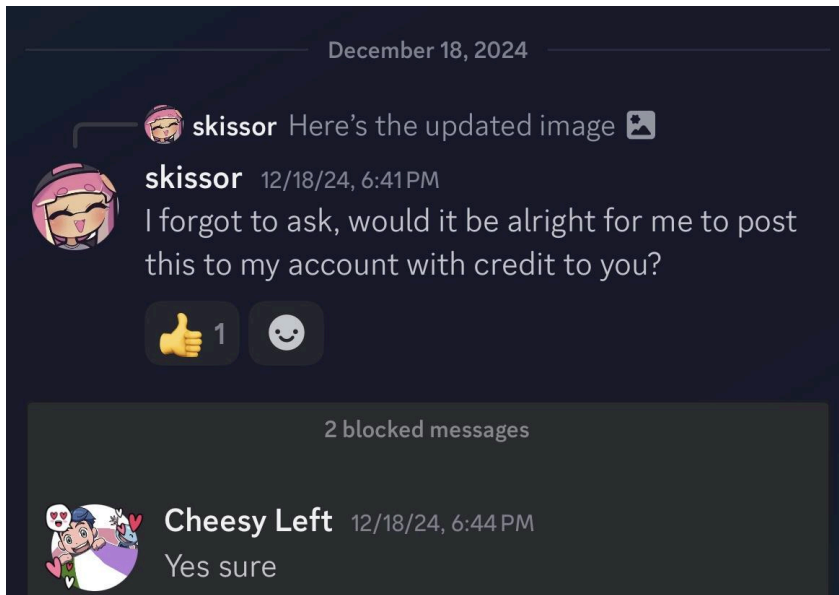

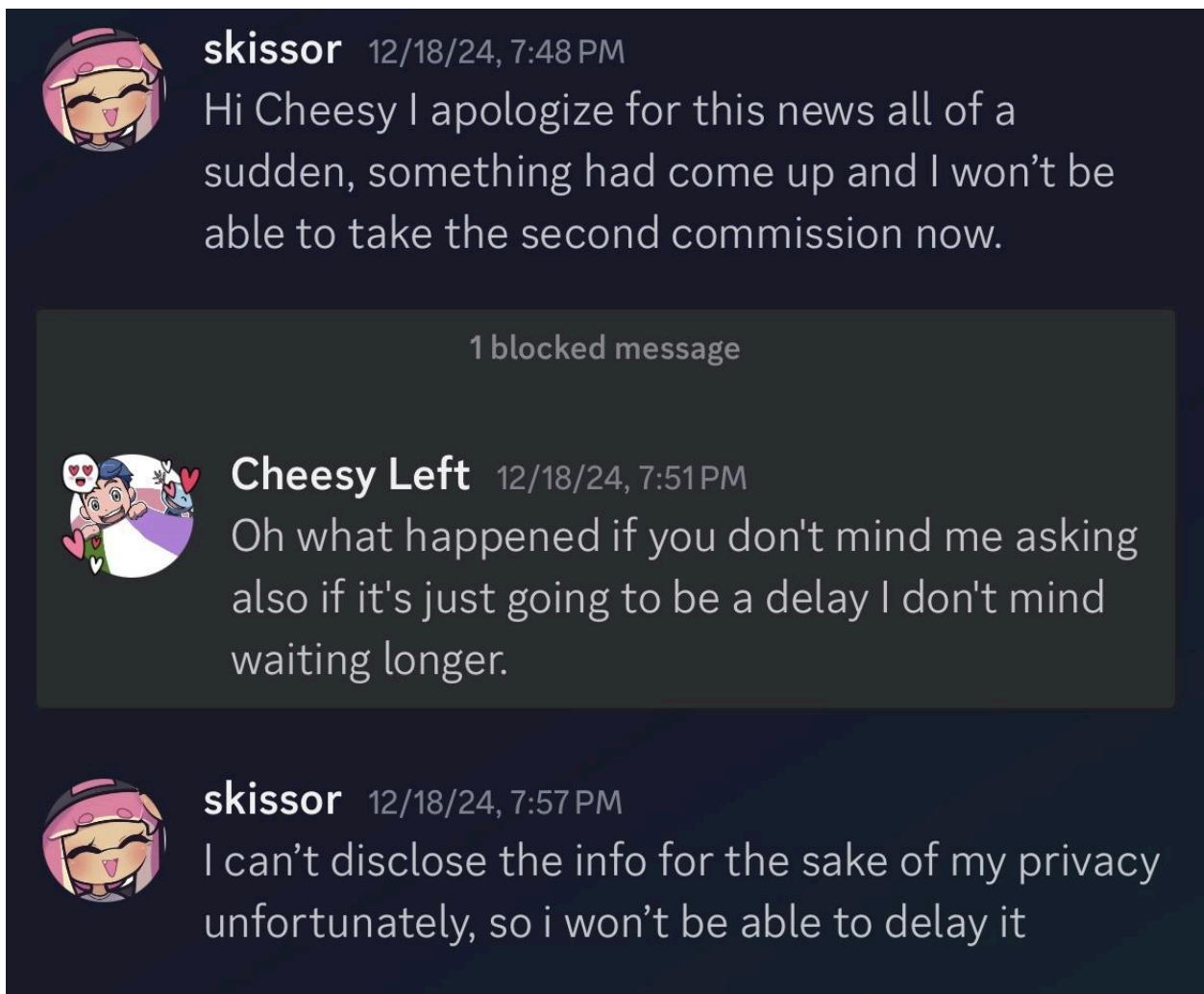

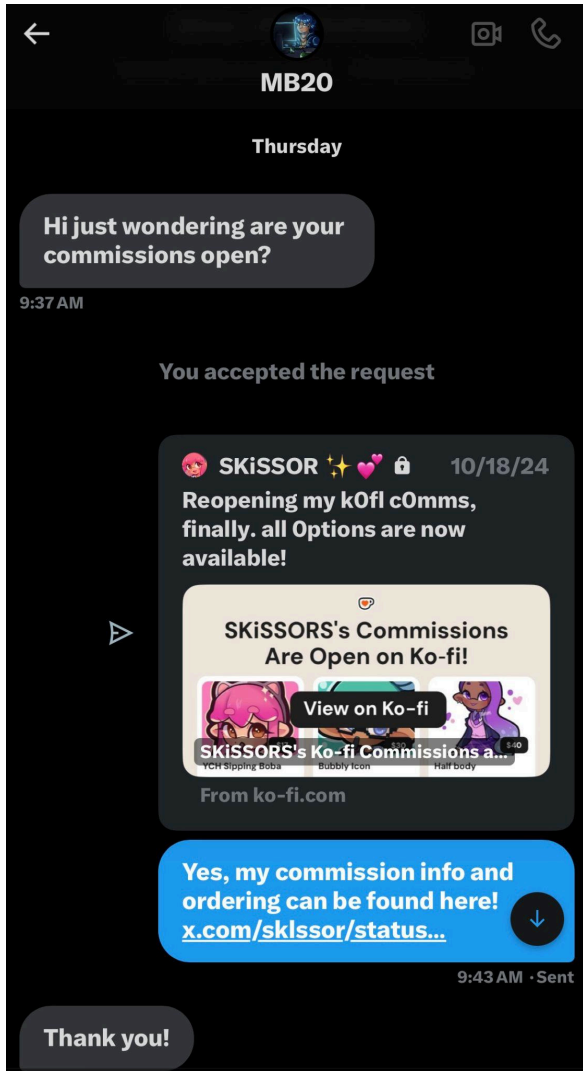


I posted this commission to my twitter account and Cheesy then requested a new commission for their friend @minebros20. Before December 19, 2024 I had no knowledge of who the friend

they wanted a commission for was and had only provided the friend's OC for me to draw. I had then notified Cheesy that I would be unable to complete the commission because something had come up:



I had never once stated that my commissions were closed or that the reason for refusing was personal. Cheesy had then had their friend who the commission was for to message me to see if they could get a commission from me. I had no prior knowledge or reason to believe that this was the friend Cheesy was requesting a commission for as Cheesy gave me zero indication of who the friend was. Upon receiving a dm request asking about my commissions, I sent my commissions form because my commissions were open (as stated that they were never closed at all). Me interacting with the friend that the commission was allegedly for:



Cheesy had then sent me screenshots of the conversation with their friend and the screenshot from the conversation I had with the friend about my commissions being open (shown above), to “prove” that I was lying about my commissions being closed. Upon receiving this, I was first of all triggered from previous events being texted behind my back from an account to try and get info off of me secretly, and stated to Cheesy that I did not appreciate the dishonesty and trying to set me up, while I had no idea who the friend was:

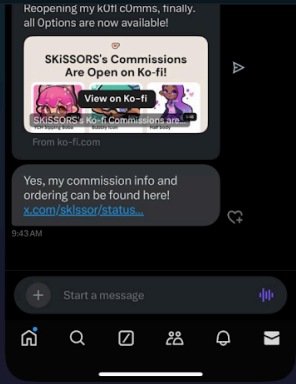



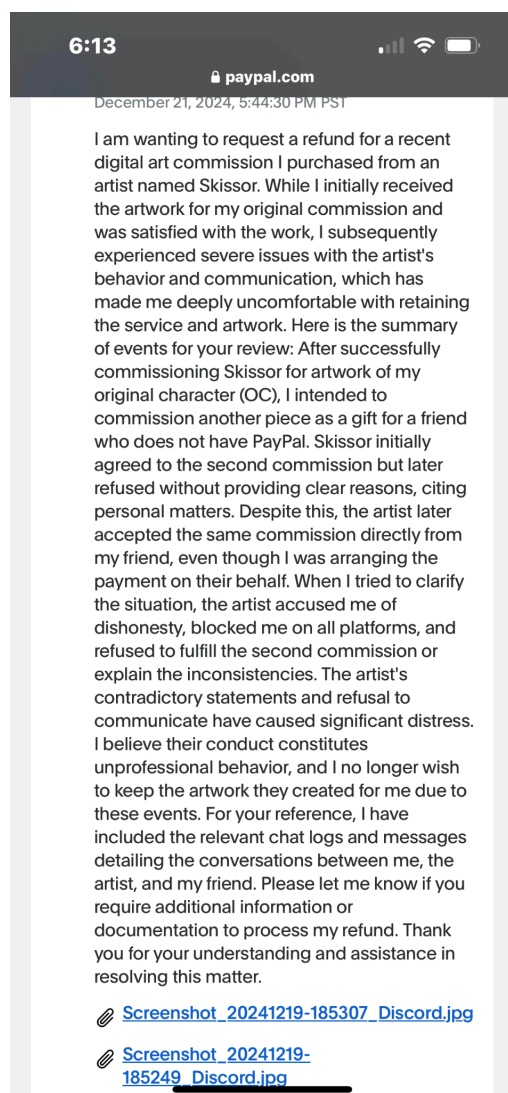

After finding out I was being set up and texted by someone that I had no idea was related to the commission with Cheesy is when I had stated “personal matters” but Cheesy had stated it was personal before then. I had not wanted to say anything on this matter because I wanted to brush past it as I had been dealing with exams that very day and work but had been labeled as having lied to Cheesy. However, today during work I had received an email from paypal stating that Cheesy was requesting a refund for the commission I had completed and that they were satisfied with over this situation of me refusing the 2nd commission:



I received this statement from paypal of Cheesy requesting the refund because of the issue created with me refusing the second commission. I believe this is unfair because I had completed the commission and they were satisfied with it, and they had not even sent me the money for the second commission so there is nothing from me that is owed to them at this point. Upon first receiving this commission Cheesy had told me they couldn't use Ko-Fi (which my commissions are listed on) because it's unavailable where they live. I searched this on google and found that Ko-Fi is not blacklisted in any countries so long as you have paypal (which Cheesy does have because they are trying to request a refund from me now). I feel very frustrated, upset, and lied to with all this on top of all the stress I've had in my own life over a

situation that I have tried to handle as professionally as possible. If I need to add more proof of screenshots I'd be more than willing to provide the whole chat history.
