COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana (Felony)

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(1), with reference to: 152.025.4(b)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/23/2024

Control #(ICR#): 24004152

Charge Description: On or about May 23, 2024, in the County of Kandiyohi, Minnesota, April Diane Imholte did possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance, to wit: possessed more than .25 grams of cocaine.

The Complainant states that the following facts establish probable cause:

Your Complainant, a licensed peace officer, is employed by the Kandiyohi County Sheriff's Office. In this capacity, your Complainant believes the following to be true and correct.

On May 23, 2024, at approximately 9:13 a.m., a search warrant was executed at 12291 51st Street in Spicer, Kandiyohi County, Minnesota. NICHOLAS ROBERT REKIETA, DOB: 12/16/81, and KAYLA CHRISTINE REKIETA, DOB: 03/09/84, reside at the residence. As law enforcement approached the residence, NICHOLAS REKIETA was traveling southbound on 51st in a vehicle.

NICHOLAS REKIETA was stopped by law enforcement. Upon knocking on the door, a juvenile female opened the door and wouldn't let them in. NICHOLAS REKIETA would not provide the door code to enter the residence. Law enforcement entered the home utilizing a door ram.

Upon entry, law enforcement located KAYLA REKIETA and APRIL IMHOLTE, DOB: 12/20/1994, and four juveniles were also in the home. KAYLA REKIETA and IMHOLTE were located in the master bedroom. Officers noted the home was extremely cluttered. There were clothes everywhere, dirty dishes, dust, and an overall dirty home.

NICHOLAS REKIETA returned to the home with law enforcement. He demanded a copy of search warrant. When given a copy, he looked at it and threw it on the ground.

During the search, law enforcement located the following in the master bedroom:

The following items were located in the master bedroom near the nightstand:

- Yellow snort tube – positive for cocaine
- Black vial with white substance inside that field tested positive for cocaine and weighed 2.2 grams
- (2) credit cards listed to IMHOLTE. The yellow snort tube and the black vial containing cocaine were found directly on top of the credit cards.
- (2) .22 caliber spent shell casings on the floor of the nightstand in the master bedroom

The following item was located underneath the bed in the master bedroom:

- Sig Sauer AR with several magazines and loose ammunition, serial number 20G002638

The following item was located in the master bedroom dresser:

- Glass container with metal filter and grinder & glass container that field tested positive for cocaine

The following items were located in a safe in the master bathroom:

- Bag with cards and dollar bill that field tested positive for cocaine
- Large corner-cut baggie with white powder that field tested positive for cocaine and weighed 18.96 grams with packaging
- (3) small baggies that field tested positive for cocaine and weighed 5.49 grams with packaging
- 8 Green colored tablets that field tested positive for Ketamine
- Digital scale that field tested positive for cocaine
- Metal pan with white powder on it that tested positive for cocaine
- (2) snort tubes and (2) metal cutters. The snort tubes tested positive for cocaine

The following items were located in a safe in the master bedroom closet:

- \$100.00 bill with white powder residue that field tested positive for cocaine
- Bindle white bag with white powder substance that field tested positive for cocaine
- Cocaine scooper
- (2) baggies within a baggie with a funnel
- Unknown Brown Substance

Additional firearms and ammunition were located in the garage.

IMHOLTE'S purse was located in the hallway inside the master bedroom leading to the attached bathroom.

The total amount of measurable cocaine in the master bedroom was 26.67 grams with packaging. Cocaine is a Schedule II controlled substance. Ketamine is a Schedule I controlled substance.

Detective Pomplun met with NICHOLAS REKIETA outside the residence. He was read his Miranda rights, and he agreed to speak with officers without counsel. NICHOLAS REKIETA indicated that he sleeps in the master bedroom with KAYLA REKIETA. He indicated that IMHOLTE was at the home visiting.

NICHOLAS REKEITA and KAYLA REKEITA were placed under arrest. While being placed

under arrest, Detective Pomplun noted several injuries to the arms of NICHOLAS REKIETA that appeared consistent with sores that are common with controlled substance users.

They were transported to the Kandiyohi County Jail. KAYLA REKIETA did not speak with officers.

At the Kandiyohi County Jail, NICHOLAS REKIETA was again read his Miranda rights and agreed to speak with officers without an attorney. NICHOLAS REKIETA refused to answer any questions regarding cocaine or other controlled substance use. NICHOLAS REKIETA indicates that he lives in the residence. He stays in the master bedroom with his wife, KAYLA REKIETA. IMHOLTE was a friend who was visiting and does not live at the residence.

While being booked into the jail, KAYLA REKIETA requested that her prescription medication be brought to her. Upon reviewing the prescription bottles for KAYLA REKIETA that were brought to the jail, jail staff found 2 unknown pills and gummies in one of the prescription bottles. These items did not match the prescription on the bottle.

KAYLA REKIETA informed child protection workers that IMHOLTE is their live-in nanny.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE: Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 609.49 intentional failure to appear for duly scheduled court appearances may result in additional criminal charges in addition to any arrest warrant that may otherwise be issued by the Court.
