### MOTION TO EXPEDITE



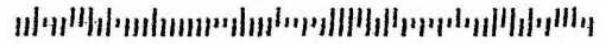
