
14th Amendment - No state shall make or enforce any law which shall abridge the privileges or immunities of citizens of the United States; nor shall any state deprive any person of life, liberty, or property without due process of law; nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws.

The state's probable cause affirms my lawful intent while acting with deliberate indifference, intentional inaction, obdurancy and mindless recitation of policies and procedures as a means to abridge my rights; 1st, 4th, 5th, 6th, 8th and 14th, depriving me of life, liberty and property by using legal process as punishment to coerce convictions.
