Not once did Natty call their friend out for promoting transphobic language & toxic masculinity by implying that the Miss Universe Malaysia was masculine therefore that made her physically unattractive; yes, Miss Universe Malaysia deserves to be criticized for her problematic words, but making comments about her appearance is uncalled for, especially when they in turn denigrate a marginalized group AKA the trans community. I also find it rather anti-black that Natty would accuse Magenta, who literally just said that she is a BLACK woman, of being

performative and boastful, when she was only expressing her frustrations as a queer Black woman...

Exhibit B

OP (orange) made an auction for himself and referred to himself as “hapa” (he’s half Japanese half white) and that he’s “Hawaiian” (from Hawaii, not native). I don’t have the original screenshot of his auction anymore, but below is what Natty had to say in response.

While Natty isn’t wrong that many “kanaka maoli” (aka native Hawaiians) don’t approve of the term “hapa” being used by non-native Hawaiians, as the word has been constantly misused and appropriated since “hapa” was historically used by native Hawaiians to describe anyone who was mixed race (the direct translation for hapa is “half,” “part,” or “mixed” in Hawaiian, but it has been appropriated by non-Hawaiians to mean someone who is part Asian heritage)... Natty isn’t in a position to be ‘splaining indigeneous Hawaiian culture to someone who actually lives in Hawaii. Remember in the previous screenshots above where Natty admitted that they don’t identify with mestizx culture and that they consider themselves as someone with “settler privilege”? Then why are they speaking to OP as if they have authority on indigenous issues, then claiming that they are NDN? You will see in more screenshots I’m about to reveal that Natty has a habit of using the ethnicities they identify with to make their arguments appear more credible. Also, notice Natty’s comment to Cyan, where they deny being white (“assuming i’m white because I denounce appropriation)... but if you revisit the screenshot I posted on page 2 of this document, Natty clearly states that they are part white.

In summary, I’m all for calling people out for using problematic language and cultural appropriation, but I don’t think Natty, a white passing individual who has admitted to having settler privilege and not really identifying with their mestizx culture, but seemingly only identifies that part to make their arguments more credible, is in a position to be that person who spearheads that conversation... since they aren’t native Hawaiian nor a resident of Hawaii.

Conclusion

To summarize, Natty Yttan has a reputation in many subtle asian groups such as SADisco and is constantly instigating unnecessary fights & causing drama in the name of “social justice.”

They engage in problematic behavior such as speaking over POC and not checking their white passing privilege. They identify as non-binary and claim to never misgender trans folx even if they disagree with them, but clearly that wasn't the case with Colette.
