**ORDER**

By order filed May 17, 2022, petitioner was directed to either pay the \$500 docketing fee, or file with this court a motion for leave to proceed on appeal in forma pauperis by June 16, 2022. To date, the required submission has not been received from petitioner. Upon consideration of the foregoing and respondent's motion to dismiss, it is

**ORDERED**, on the court's own motion, that petitioner show cause by August 1, 2022, why this case should not be dismissed for failure to pay or file a motion for leave to proceed on appeal in forma pauperis. The response to the order to show cause may not exceed the length limitations established by Fed. R. App. P. 27(d)(2) (5,200 words if produced using a computer; 20 pages if handwritten or typewritten). Failure by petitioner to respond to this order may result in dismissal of the case for lack of prosecution. See D.C. Cir. Rule 38. It is

**FURTHER ORDERED** that consideration of the motion to dismiss be deferred pending further order of the court.
