On 09-17-12 at about 0829 hrs. I was dispatched to a report of a VNCO, having occurred at the reporting parties place of employment at 924 Capitol. Reading the text of the attached CAD event - I was familiar with the suspect, having met him just the day before. I made phone contact with the complainant Suzanne Rose who reported the following to me.

Rose works at the Information desk of the Grange at 924 Capitol, her desk being just inside the lobby doors. Shortly after 0800 hrs. Rose saw her ex-boyfriend Lucas Werner walking toward the front doors of her place of employment. He walked in and, as he was approaching and looking directly at her, said something similar to "remove the no-contact order", and "I love you". Rose stood up and repeatedly told Lucas to get out. Lucas walked right up to Rose and attempted to hug her, but she pushed him away. Lucas left the building, saying "you are going to burn in hell".

Lucas Werner has been served the attached No-Contact Order, which prohibits him from contact

Having just had contact with Werner the day before, I recalled him saying he was staying at The Olympia Inn at 909 Capitol. I went there and confirmed with staff that Werner was staying in room # 109. I attempted contact, but got no response at the door. After checking the downtown area for Werner, I drove back by the Olympia Inn, at which time the clerk flagged me down and said he saw Werner open his room door right after I left. Officer Brown joined me, and we again attempted contact at room #109. After no response I opened the door and saw Werner emerging from the bathroom. We took Werner into custody without incident, telling him he was under arrest for violating the no-contact order. I did not ask Werner any questions, but he spontaneously offered that "it was a bad idea to go to her work".

I transported Werner to OPD Jail where he was booked.

Upon reviewing the attached No-Contact Order I noted the requirement that Werner not be within 500' of Rose's place of employment. His room at The Olympia Inn is well within that distance, roughly 200' from his room to Rose's desk.

Rose provided the attached written statement.


