ORDER ON NOVEMBER 8, 2019 HEARING

On November 8, 2019, the Court considered Monica Rial and Ronald Toye's ("Moving Defendants") Motion to Compel Deposition and Documents of Chris Slatosch ("Motion to Compel"), and Plaintiff Victor Mignogna's Amended Motion to Quash, Motion for Protective Order, and Motion for Sanctions. After considering the Motions, the pleadings on file, and arguments of counsel, the Court RULES as follows:.
