

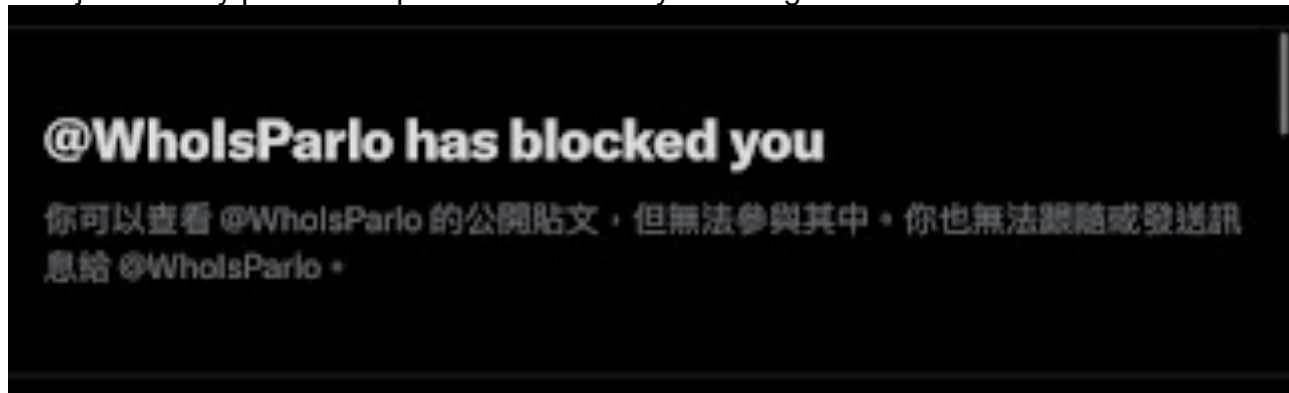

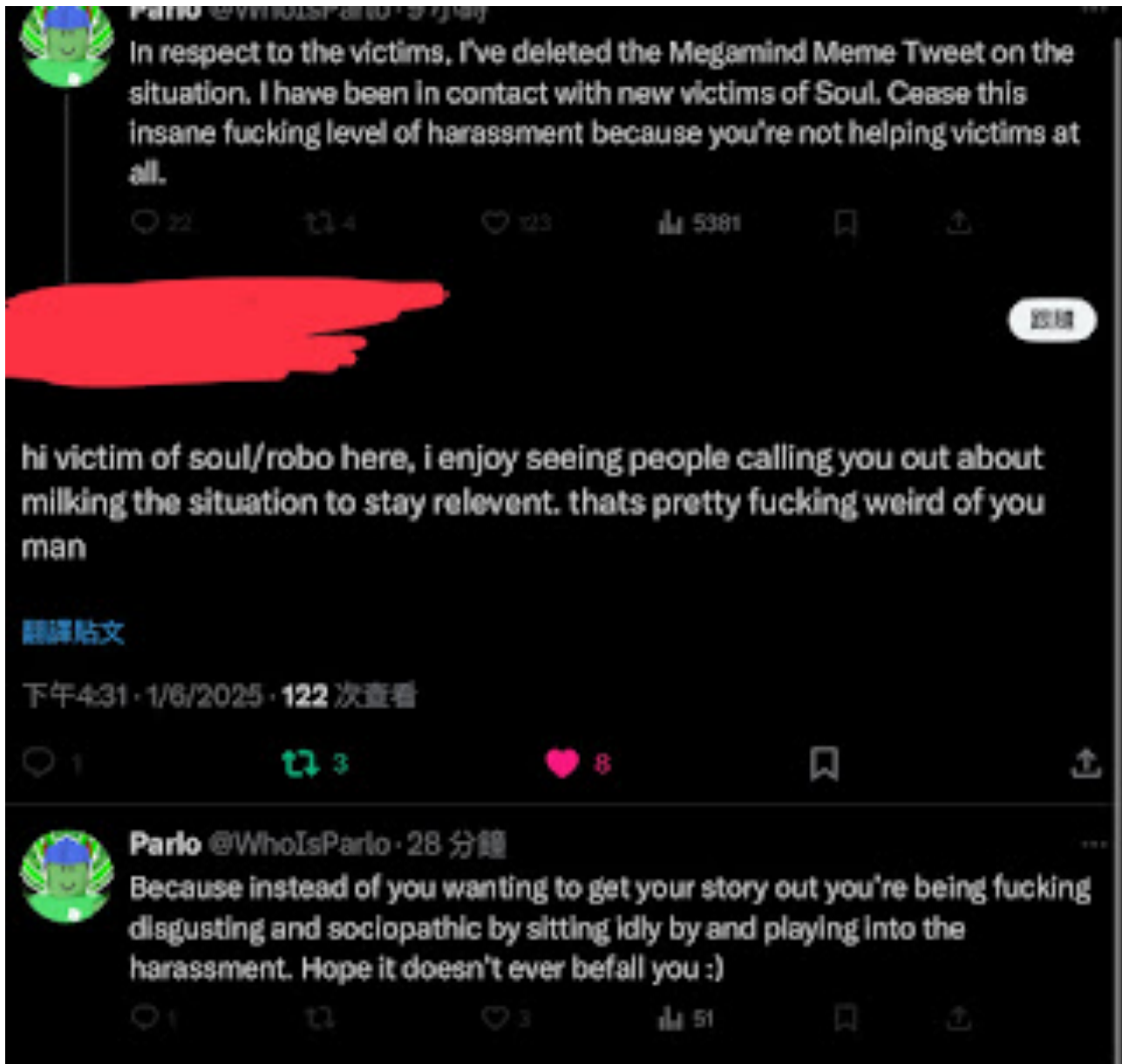
UPDATE 3 HE BLOCKED ME AGAIN.

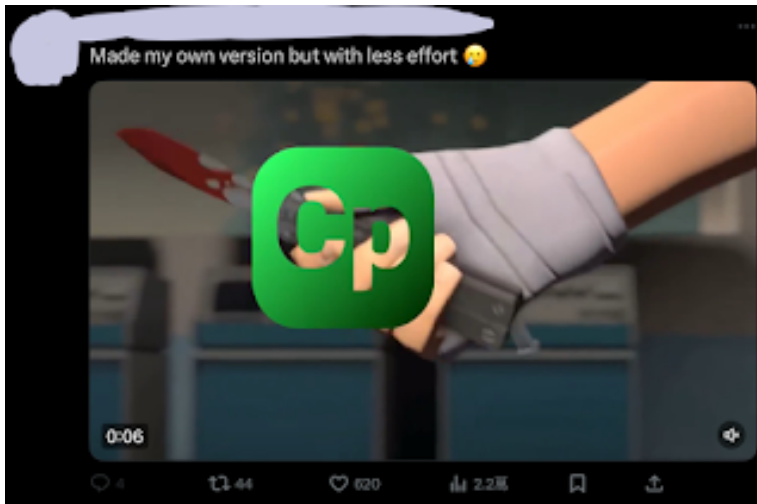

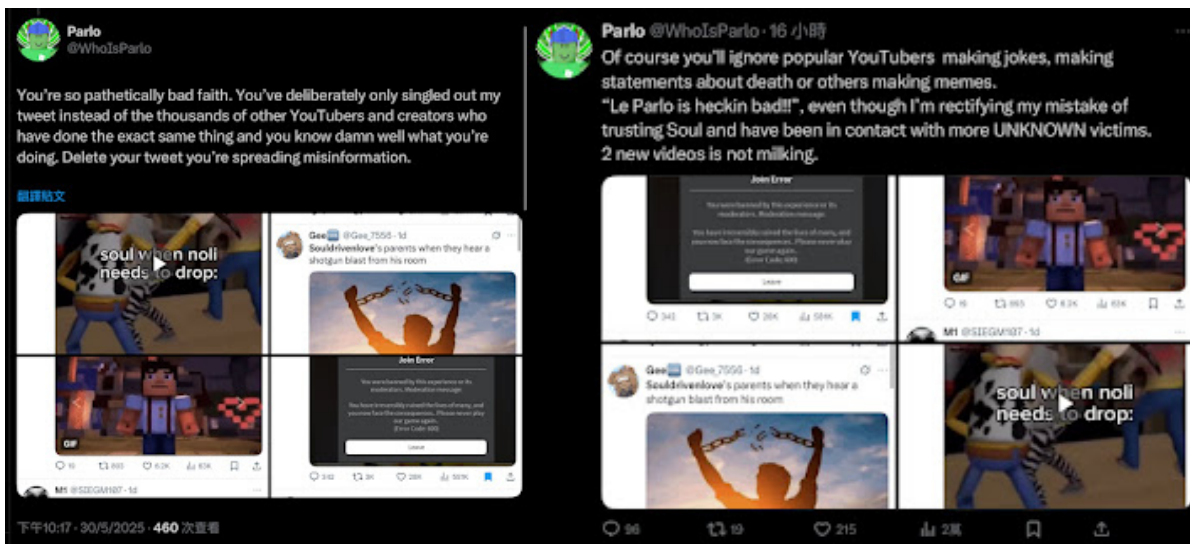


It is definitely not okay for a content creator with OVER 500K SUBSCRIBERS to turn a crime into a meme. He even pinned it which is crazy:

- Disrespecting victims: Memes are used for humor or lighthearted commentary. When applied to crimes, especially those which involve real victims who are suffering, it can lower the seriousness of the event and be deeply disrespectful and hurtful to the victims and anyone affected by the crime.
- Normalization: Turning a crime into a meme normalize or desensitize audiences to criminal behaviour. When serious incidents are reduced to a such a short meme like this, it can blur the lines between right and wrong, making it seem less severe than it is.
- Misinformation and Lack of Context: Memes are short, visual, and lack of information. Using them to represent a crime can lead to misinformation, oversimplification, and a distorted understanding of what happened.
- Abuse of Influence: A creator with OVER 500,000 SUBSCRIBERS on YouTube and 7K FOLLOWERS on Twitter has a powerful platform. Using this influence to spread joke content that involves crime is an irresponsible use of that power. Content creators have a responsibility to consider the impact of their content on their audience and society.
- Misinterpretation: While some people might argue it's some sort of "dark humor" whatever, a "meme" means it can be easily misinterpreted, especially by younger or less informed audiences on the platform, as a lighthearted joke.
- Attempting to justify his actions: You've already made a mistake by trusting too much of soul's words, why do you still act nonchalant and joke about it like it's nothing? The argument "I've already made two videos" does not justify what you did is wrong.
- This is the transcript at the end of his second latest video regarding Soul: *"[Now I really do wish that people treat this situation with respect and maturity and don't make jokes about it] and for certain people as well to not rush into insane accusations without taking into account the context of the situation at hand."* Now, why would you joke about the drama when you've clearly said you hope people to "treat this situation with respect and maturity and don't make jokes about it"? **This is hypocritical of you to do so.**



• **You cannot deny the influence you have on your fans.** As you can see, this person made another version of the crime meme and posted it under your post.

 - “Rectifying my mistakes of trusting soul” Then you could’ve TAKEN DOWN THE TWO VIDEOS YOU MADE IN THE PAST. I still do not understand why you have to keep them up as “archive purposes” when people can actually be misinformed about it. You have to acknowledge that not everyone will actually click on your channel and watch all your videos. The least you could’ve done is to clarify in the video title that it has been debunked and that you were lied to.

Regarding "Spreading misinformation", below **I'll also own up to the mistakes in my posts** as both sides are wrong, but I have my reasons.



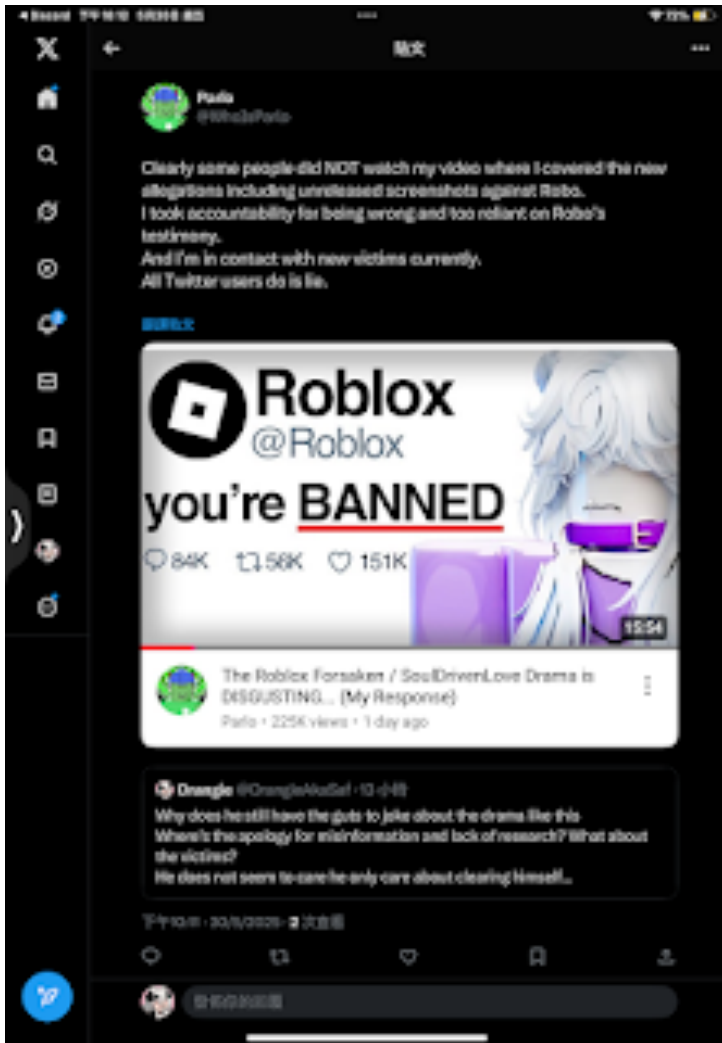
This is the transcript at the end of his second latest video regarding Soul:

"Now, while I do stand my ground against the inherently malicious and fictitious comments from Twitter users, attempting to find anyone to blame, basically being me, [I do take accountability for not pushing back on more of the information, which Soul was stating, and also not digging into the Nico and Chi situation specifically. Their document was deleted. However, I didn't know the reason for why that was the case. And it was also extremely hard to decipher what points were being made in them. However, I'd like to preface that many of the claims presented in my soul video still do stand. I should have pushed back and I should not have taken their word as holy gospel, but the only thing that you can deduce from this situation was that I was far too trusting of them and I did not assume for them to have openly lied to my face about what they did.] I was not paid off and I did not see the crazy horrible information against so and decide to withhold it. This childish, pathetic idea that I knew all along is completely untrue. And that's why no one outside of Twitter will take a Twitter user seriously."

- From your apology *"I do take accountability for not pushing back on more of the information, which Soul was stating, and also not digging into the Nico and Chi situation specifically."* And how will you prevent this from happening again? You did not explain how you'll improve in the video, hence I believe it's fair for me to think that you did not learn.

- As for apologies, I believe putting it before the video is a way better option than at the end. Why? Because it shows that you're urgent and serious with the situation. Placing the apology first shows that you understand the gravity of the situation and are prioritizing addressing the issue, and you're not trying to hide or downplay the situation. *"I am truly sorry for _____, and I take full accountability for _____. I have reflected on and I will improve by _____."* Would've been WAY better than that. Parlo, you're an adult and I believe you can understand this.

You knew what you were doing when you quoted my post when you have such a large platform filled with people who supports you blindly. I was extremely devastated and in complete shock when I saw you posting this that I immediately had a mental breakdown. And yes I deleted the post immediately because if I don't I'm gonna get harassed by multiple people, not to mention there were literally people celebrating that I deleted the post.

Regarding the post you made, "taking accountability" and making two new videos DOES NOT give you the right to joke about the situation, and it looks very bad on you who literally made mistakes by trusting Soul's words easily before. You brought yourself into the drama yet you're acting nonchalant as if you're right about everything.

It is absolutely not okay for a big content creator, or any content creator, to attempt to get their fans to harass anyone, especially without knowing their age.

- Online Harassment is Harmful: Inciting harassment, commonly known as "mobbing" or "brigading," can lead to emotional distress, anxiety, depression, and even physical safety concerns for the target. It's a form of cyber bullying.

- Abuse of Power and Influence: Content creators with large followings have significant influence over their audience. Using this influence to direct negative attention and harassment towards an individual is gross and is an abuse of their platform and power.

What you could've done is just simply clarify by making a post without anyone attached or clarify by replying.

You have been actively blocking people who made criticism about you. It's time you have to own up to your mistakes and do what is right. Not to mention you had been harassing people on your alt account publicly. Please reflect on your actions, and learn the difference between hate with malicious intents and critics about your behaviour. You're a grown adult with a huge platform.
