1) HOW VIOLATION OCCURRED:

Violation of Special Condition of the Order of Probation, by failing to comply with all instructions given to him by the court, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated his probation, Officer James Woods states that on 09/21/2022, the offender was instructed to permanently close/delete Official Metro State YouTube Channel and provide proof to probation within 60 days of release of these closures, and the offender did fail to carry out this instruction as of 11/17/2022.

On 09/21/2022, the offender was instructed to permanently close/delete Official Metro State YouTube Channel and provide proof to probation within 60 days of release of these closures. On 09/10/2022, the offender was released from prison and as of 11/17/2022, the Metro State YouTube Channel is still up and not closed/deleted as ordered by the court.

Additional Violations:

Violation of Special Condition of the Order of Probation, by failing to follow the rules of electronic monitoring, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated his probation, Officer James Woods states that on 11/29/2022 the offender refused to follow the rules of electronic monitoring .

On 09/17/2021, the offender was ordered by the court to be placed on GPS monitoring for 2 years upon his release from prison (9/10/22). On 09/12/2022, the offender was instructed on the Electronic Monitoring Equipment Assignment Rules and signed indicating he understood the EM rules. The Electronic Monitoring Equipment Assignment Rule 15 states, "the Offender must respond immediately to all messages/phone calls sent to your tracking device. When contacted, you must follow any instruction given to you by a Probation Officer or the monitoring center staff. On 11/29/22 Officer Woods attempted to contact the offender at his home. The offender's GPS location points showed him being at his residence. At approximately 1343 hours, this officer called the offender's tracking device multiple times and the offender failed to answer the tracking device. The device could be heard ringing in the home while calling. After attempting to call the offender several times with no answer, this officer sent a text message to the offender on his

could be heard ringing in the home while calling. After attempting to call the offender several times with no answer, this officer sent a text message to the offender on his tracking device (RTC) instructing the offender to go outside to meet with probation. The first message was sent at on 11/29/22 at 1347 hours and the offender, by pushing a button on the device, acknowledged he received the message at 1359 hours. The offender failed to follow instructions to go outside to meet with probation. A second text message was sent at 1422 hours. Again, the offender acknowledged receipt of the message by pushing a button on the device at 1423 hours but did not exit his residence. It is clear the offender was in his home, acknowledged receiving the instruction, and still failed to follow the instructions.

Violation of Condition (B) of the Order of Probation, by failing to allow his officer to visit in his home, or elsewhere, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated his probation, Officer James Woods states that on 11/29/2022, the offender refused to allow Officer James Woods entry into his home located at 2404 Accord Ter, Kissimmee, Florida 34758.

On 11/29/2022 at approximately 1343 hours, this Officer and Supervisor Steinmeyer attempted to make face to face contact with the offender at his residence. The offender's GPS location points showed he was at his residence. This officer called the offender's cellphone number and the tracking device multiple times. The offender failed to answer his phone and the tracking device. It should be noted that this officer could hear the offender's tracking device ringing as this officer made calls. This officer sent a text message to his tracking device instructing the offender to come outside. The offender acknowledged that he received it. This Officer and Supervisor Steinmeyer knocked on the front door and rang the ring doorbell multiple times. This officer called for the offender and the offender did not answer the door. This officer knocked on the front window and called for the offender to come to the door and the offender did not answer. Supervisor Steinmeyer walked through an open side gate into the back yard and knocked on the side window and the offender failed to answer. The offender's GPS location points showed the offender was at home and he acknowledged he received the message instructing him to go outside. It is clear the offender was aware probation was at the home trying to contact him however failed to let probation into his home.

4) RECOMMENDATION:

Jeremy Dewitte is currently in custody in the Orange County Jail, so a warrant is not being requested at this time. This officer is recommending the offender's probation be revoked and he be sentenced to a period of incarceration in the Florida Department of Corrections.

On 09/21/2022, the offender was placed on probation for 48 months. The offender was released from prison on 09/10/2022. On 09/21/2022, the offender was instructed by this officer to permanently close/delete his Official Metro State YouTube Channel and provide proof to probation within 60 days of release. Each time this condition was discussed with the offender he claimed he did not have access to his YouTube channel and didn't know how to close it. However, the offender opened a new YouTube channel (Motor ls Moving) since his release from prison. The offender's newly posted video (The Probation Officer Who Stole Christmas) on his new YouTube channel was posted 11/29/2022.

On 11/29/2022, the offender refused to follow the rules of electronic monitoring by failing to comply with this officer's instructions of walking outside to meet this officer. On 11/29/2022, the offender refused to allow Officer James Woods entry into his home. The offender's demeanor and attitude that he has displayed both in person and on the videos posted show he is not a good candidate, and not amenable to, any type of community supervision. The offender has an extensive history with the Department of Corrections dating back to 1998. The offender has been placed on 6 forms of community supervision and was revoked on 5 of previous terms of supervision. Therefore, the offender should be sentenced to the Florida Department of Corrections.
