REQUEST FOR LEAVE TO AMEND CLAIM

Comes now, pro se Plaintiff David Stebbins, who hereby submits the following Request for Leave to Amend Claim in the above-styled action.

1. After reviewing my claim, I noticed that the “describe the infringement” section of the claim actually stopped halfway. I meant to write about twice as much as I did.
