The court SUSPENDS formal imposition of sentence (SIS) execution of sentence (SES) and orders Defendant placed on probation for 5 years under the supervision of State Board of Probation and Parole and under all terms and conditions set by them including the special condition(s) that:

Defendant shall obtain a high school equivalency diploma unless testing reveals Defendant is unable to do so;

Defendant shall not possess or use alcohol or enter any establishment where alcohol is the primary item for sale;

Defendant shall not use or possess any controlled substance except as specifically prescribed for defendant and supervised by a licensed medical practitioner;

Defendant shall complete a substance/alcohol use assessment within 45 days and complete any treatment recommended based on the assessment.

Defendant shall regularly attend a peer support group as directed by Defendant's probation officer.

Defendant shall submit to alcohol and drug testing at request of law enforcement, probation officer or prosecuting attorney.

Defendant may serve up to 120 days shock in the county jail, at the discretion of the probation officer pursuant to RSMo 559.026.

Defendant shall subject to law enforcement search of his/her residence or vehicle without probable cause.

Defendant shall not operate a motor vehicle without a valid driver's license, or limited driving privilege with an ignition interlock device, and insurance.

Defendant forfeits firearms and ammunition involved in this case pursuant to RSMo 571.095.

Defendant shall complete 160 hours of community service as directed by Probation and Parole (on or before by 2/9/28.)

Defendant shall pay restitution of \$ _____ through prosecuting attorney's office at 9 % interest per annum plus a prosecuting attorney fee of \$ _____ at a rate as directed by Probation and Parole (each month, and continuing on the same day of each month thereafter until fully paid) (to be paid in full on or before _____) (in accordance with Exhibit B, Restitution Agreement, which is admitted and fully incorporated herein).

Defendant shall pay the costs of this action as directed by Probation and Parole, pursuant to the Formal administrative plan for collection of court debt for the 39th Circuit (and on the same day of each month thereafter until fully paid) (to be paid in full on or before _____.)

Defendant shall be supervised as a Domestic Violence Offender.

Defendant shall be subject to ACTIVE electronic monitoring which detects the location of Defendant at all times via GPS. Defendant shall comply with all directives from Probation and Parole governing times and locations of Defendant's presence.

Electronic monitoring shall also detect the consumption of alcohol by Defendant.

This special condition shall remain in effect unless specifically abated by this court.

Defendant shall have no contact with the victim(s) or go upon the property where victim(s) reside, through any means or weeks.

Defendant shall no go upon the following premises: _____.

Defendant shall abide by all terms and conditions set forth in Defendant's Exhibit B, the memorandum of plea agreement, which has been admitted into evidence and is incorporated herein.

Defendant shall contact MO Board of Probation and Parole within 24 hours of disposition.
